University of Chicago Medicine Daytime Shuttles

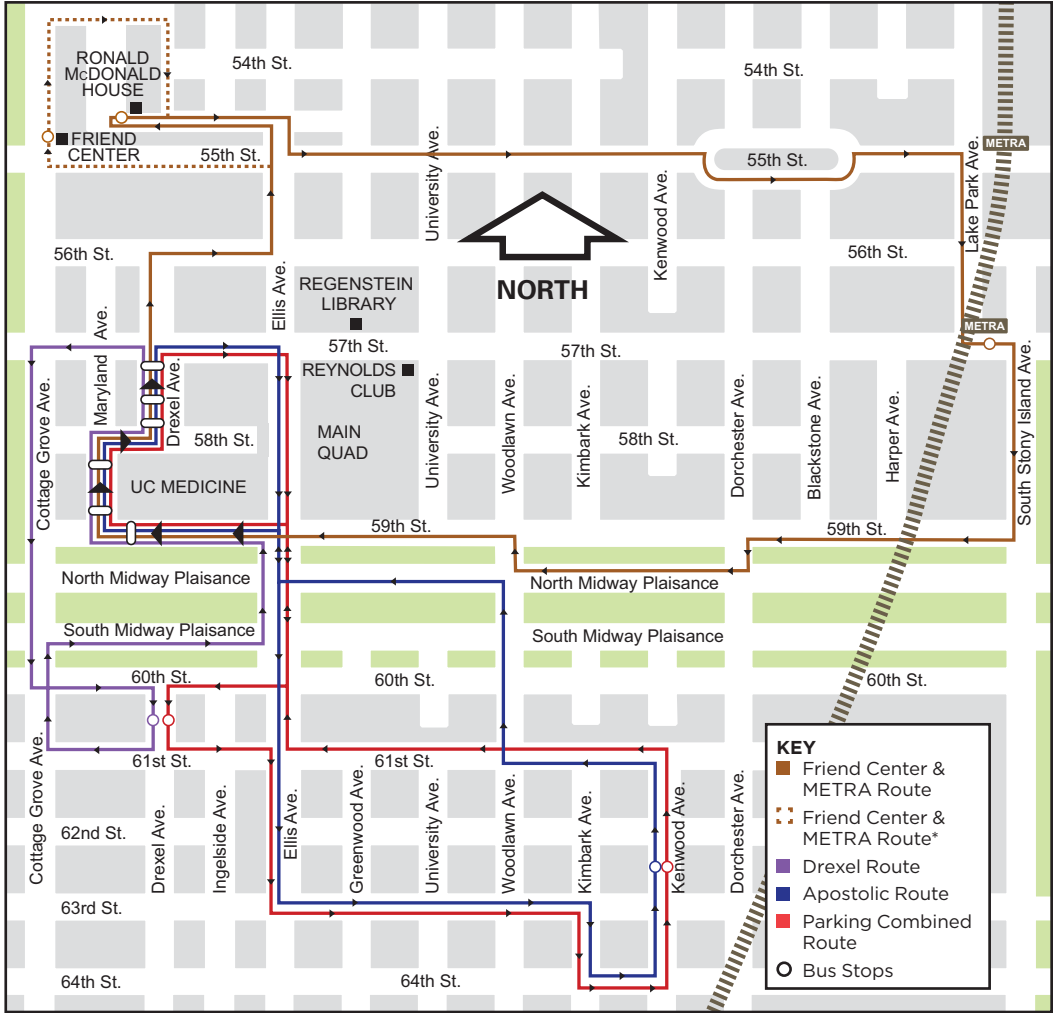
The University of Chicago provides free daytime shuttle service around the campus area and portions of the neighboring communities to all students, faculty, staff, and University of Chicago Medicine staff. The shuttles run year-round except on University-recognized holidays. For the most up-to-date information, visit the Transportation and Parking Services website at safety-security.uchicago.edu/transportation. To ride the shuttles, all passengers must present a valid UChicago ID or University of Chicago Medicine ID when boarding.

FRIEND CENTER AND METRA ROUTE
(Monday-Friday 5 a.m. to 9 p.m.). Departs 59th Street and Drexel Avenue: 0:00 and 0:30; Friend Center: 0:05 and 0:35; 57th Street Metra Station: 0:20 and 0:50. (*By request only)

DREXEL ROUTE
(Monday-Friday 5 a.m. to 10 a.m.; use Parking Combined Route after 10 a.m.). Departs 61st Street and Drexel Avenue on the tens (0:00, 0:10, 0:20, etc.).

APOSTOLIC ROUTE
(Monday-Friday 5 a.m. to 10 a.m.; use Parking Combined Route after 10 a.m.). Departs 63rd Street and Kenwood Avenue on the tens (0:00, 0:10, 0:20, etc.).

PARKING COMBINED ROUTE
(Monday-Friday 10 a.m. to 9 p.m.; picks up at both Drexel and Apostolic parking lots). Scheduled departures from 59th Street and Drexel Avenue; 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.: 0:00, 0:15, 0:30, 0:45; 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.: 0:00, 0:10, 0:20, 0:30, 0:40, 0:50; 6 p.m. to 9 p.m.: 0:00, 0:20, 0:40.





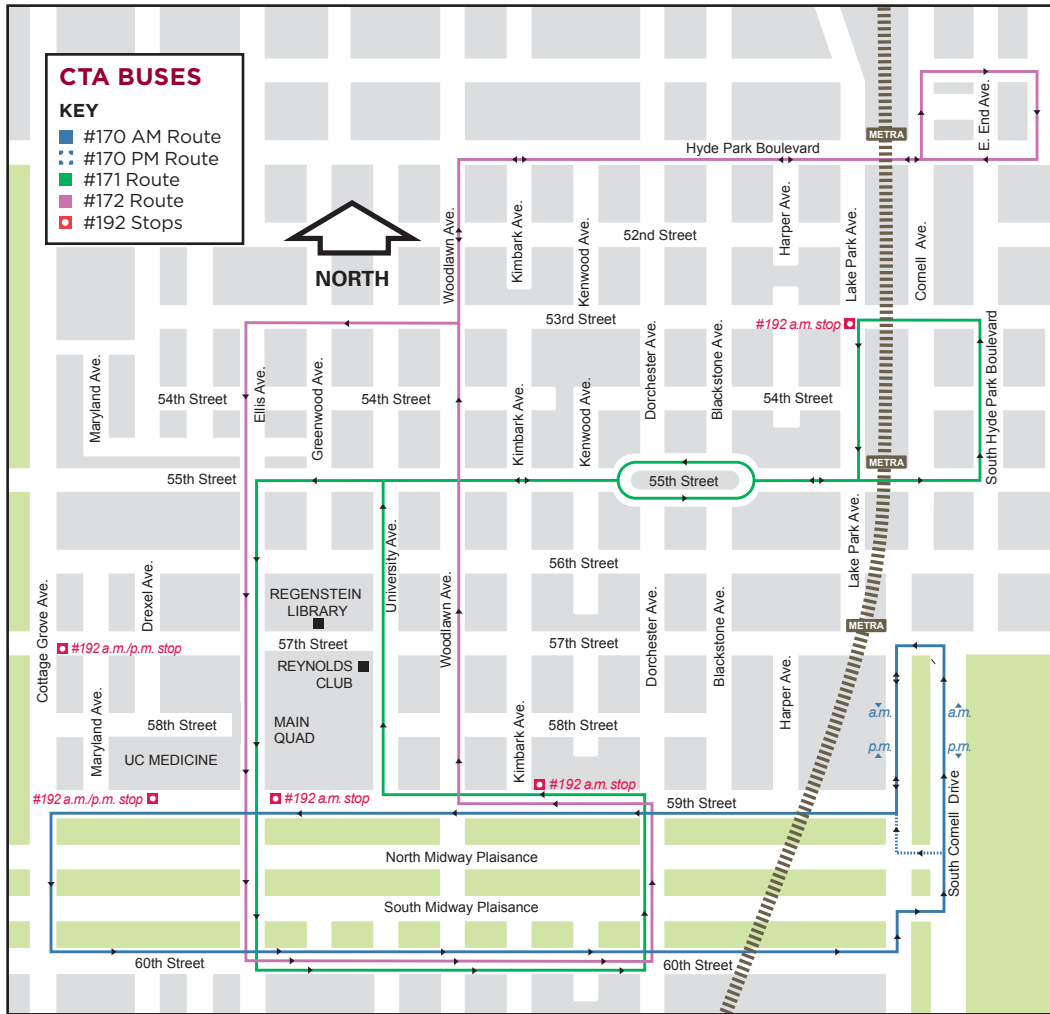
SOUTH LOOP SHUTTLE

The South Loop Shuttle operates on Friday and Saturday nights only between campus and Chicago's South Loop neighborhood. The South Loop Shuttle only stops at designated stops and does not pick up or drop off passengers at intersections. This service is free and available for University students, faculty, staff, and University of Chicago Medicine staff. To ride the shuttle, all passengers must present a valid UChicago or University of Chicago Medicine ID.

- Departs from 57th Street and University Avenue (picks up on University Avenue) on the hour from 6:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m.
- Departs from the area around the main entrance of the CTA Roosevelt Station on the half hour from 6:30 p.m. to 12:30 a.m.

DIAL-A-RIDE AND INJURED STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

All campus bus and shuttle transportation is ADA accessible. The University also provides Dial-A-Ride, a complimentary curb-to-curb bus transportation service for students with limited mobility either long-term or temporarily. The service helps arrange rides to and from regularly scheduled classes and to and from medical appointments at the University of Chicago Medicine complex. This service is available within the boundaries of Lakeshore Drive to the east, Cottage Grove Avenue to the west, 37th Street to the north, and 64th Street to the south. Service must be arranged and scheduled with Student Disability Services at least 24 business hours prior to transport needs.



CTA Buses

University students, faculty, and staff, including University of Chicago Medicine staff, ride CTA routes 170, 171, and 172 free upon displaying a valid UChicago ID, University of Chicago Medicine ID, University of Chicago Laboratory Schools ID, or University of Chicago Charter Schools ID. All other riders are required to pay the appropriate CTA fare.

#170 U. OF CHICAGO/MIDWAY
(Monday through Friday). Services the 57th Street Metra station and circles the Midway Plaisance on 59th and 60th streets. Operates Monday through Friday from 5:35 a.m. to 9:40 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. to 6:40 p.m.

#171 U. OF CHICAGO/HYDE PARK
 Services Lake Shore Drive / 54th Street and the 55th-56th-57th St. Metra station. It travels to campus on 55th Street and Ellis Avenue and then circles around campus. Operates weekdays from 7:02 a.m. to 6:32 p.m.; weekends from 8:02 a.m. to 6:32 p.m. Visit transitchicago.com for hours and wait times. After convocation, a reduced service schedule goes into effect.

#172 U. OF CHICAGO/KENWOOD
 Services Lake Shore Drive / 50th Street and the Hyde Park-53rd St. Metra station. It travels to campus on Hyde Park Boulevard and Ellis Avenue and then circles around campus. Operates weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 6:37 p.m.; weekends from 8:00 a.m. to 6:37 p.m. Visit transitchicago.com for hours and wait times. After convocation, a reduced service schedule goes into effect.

#6 JACKSON PARK EXPRESS

Must transfer to CTA #171 at the intersection

of South Hyde Park Boulevard and 53rd Street.

Operates every day.

#28 STONY ISLAND

Must transfer to CTA #172 at the intersection of

East Hyde Park Boulevard (51st Street) and Lake

Park Avenue. Operates every day.

#55 GARFIELD

(To/from Green and Red lines Garfield stop)

If traveling on the Green or Red line use this

bus to get to/from campus. Operates every day.

Exploring Chicago

CTA GREEN AND RED LINE TRAINS

The CTA's Green and Red lines run close to campus. When using these rail lines, take the #55 bus route to/from the Garfield station. Both travel to the downtown Loop area where it is easy to transfer to another train or bus. METRA ELECTRIC DISTRICT LINE

57th Street Station

Use CTA route #170 to get between campus and the stop.

55th Street Station

Use CTA route #171 to get between campus and the stop.

51st Street/Hyde Park Station

Use CTA route #172 to get between campus and the stop.

SOUTH SHORE LINE

Northern Indiana Commuter Transportation District

Runs daily between the South Bend Airport and Millennium Station. To access campus use the 57th Street Metra Station. Visit nictd.com for schedules and information.

PACE

Pace provides fixed routes in the suburbs that service more than 220 communities throughout the Chicago area. For more information about the Pace Bus System, go to pacebus.com.

CAR SHARING

The University of Chicago has partnered with I-Go and Zipcar to offer car sharing options. There are several vehicles on campus and around the Hyde Park area. For the most up-to-date information about membership rates and locations, go to igocars.com/college-students or zipcar.com/uofc.

RECYCLES BIKE SHARE / BIKING CHICAGO

Another way to get around campus and the surrounding area is by bicycle. The city has more than 170 miles of on-street protected, buffered, and shared bike lanes. All CTA buses have bike racks and bikes are allowed on CTA trains during non-peak hours. The University offers the free ReCycles Bike Share program. Tips for Your Trip

ID POLICY

When boarding any University shuttle, all passengers must present a valid UChicago or University of Chicago Medicine ID.

TRANSLOC

All UGo shuttles and CTA routes that service campus are equipped with GPS tracking. Shuttle movements and arrivals can be tracked online, on a mobile device, or on one of the monitors located in various buildings around campus. TransLoc also displays any announcements and alerts that may affect the shuttles' movements. Shuttle tracking can also be done on the UChicago mobile app which you can download from the iTunes store.

Goroo is a resource to help plan trips around the greater Chicago area. The site is powered by the Regional Transit Authority (RTA) and includes all modal options: CTA, Metra, and Pace, as well as information for walkers, bikers, and even drivers.



PLAN FOR WEATHER AND SPECIAL EVENTS

Before heading out the door, plan ahead and prepare for your trip around campus or the greater Hyde Park area. Plan for weather, special events, or peak travel times. In the event of a delay or reroute, alerts are posted on the Transportation & Parking Services website and the TransLoc website and monitors.

PARKING LOTS AND GARAGES

Transportation and Parking Services manages various surface parking lots and Ellis Garage for on-campus parking. Free parking is available on a first come, first serve basis at the parking lot located at 60th Street and Stony Island Avenue. For daily and monthly rates at University-managed lots, visit safety-security.uchicago.edu/transportation/parking.

THE PARKING OFFICE

The Parking Office is located on the south side ground level of the Ellis Garage at 5525 South Ellis Avenue, Room 171. Office hours are 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday. Visit the Parking Office for any questions about transportation or parking on or around the University of Chicago campus.

ALTERNATIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAMS

To help reduce the number of single occupancy vehicles arriving to campus, the University offers two comprehensive alternative transportation programs. Eligible University students, faculty, and staff may enroll in the Carpool Program and enjoy discounted or free parking privileges.

Enrollment in the qualifying commuter benefits program allows participants to enroll in the Occasional Parking Program and receive a limited quantity of parking passes for access to the Ellis Garage. Benefits-eligible University staff and faculty can pay for qualifying transportation programs through the University's Commuter Benefits administrator (Conexis).

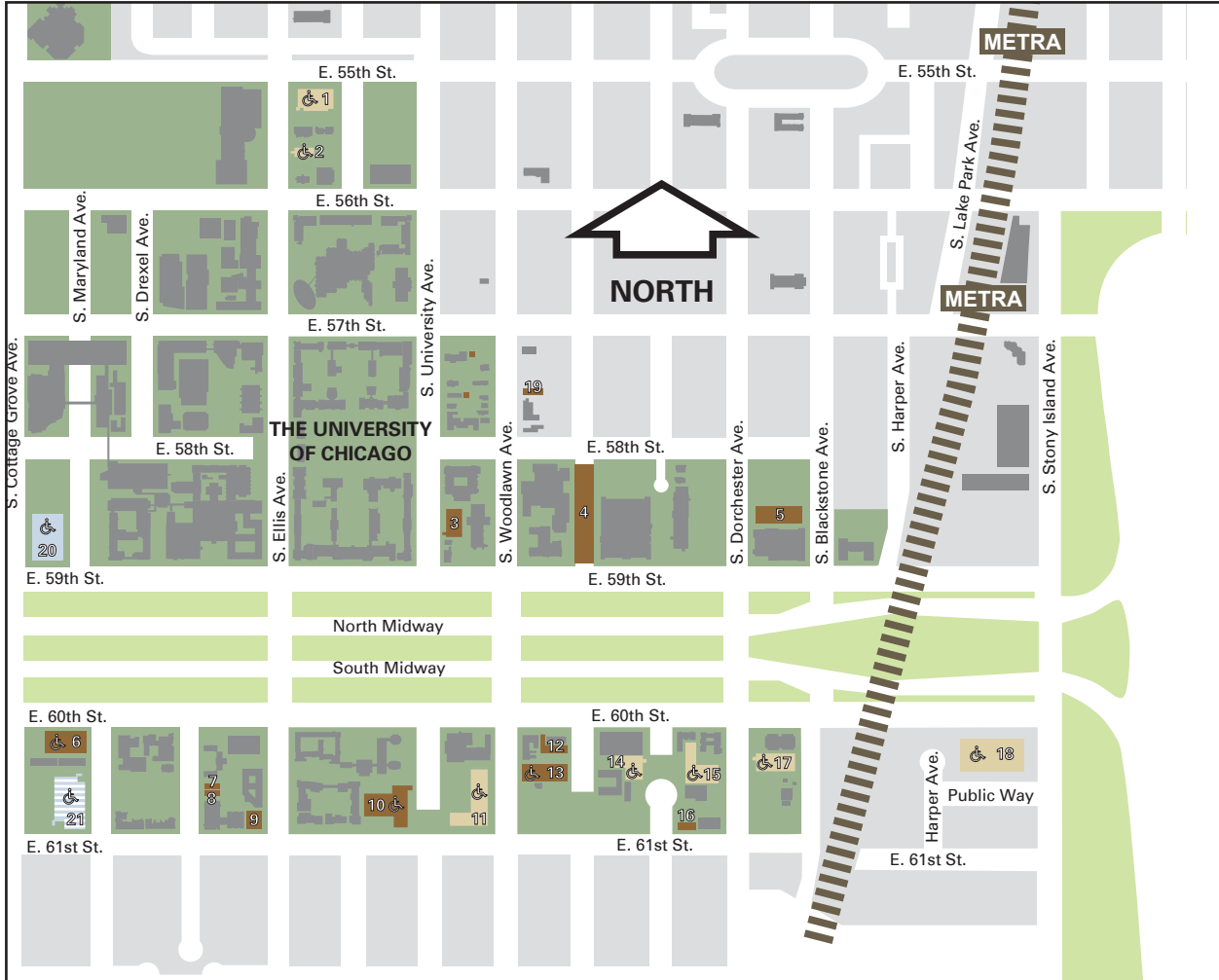

WINTER STREET PARKING AND SNOW EMERGENCIES








From December 1 to April 1, the city of Chicago's winter overnight parking ban covers various arterial streets throughout the city. No vehicles can be parked on designated streets from 3 a.m. to 7 a.m. during this period. On campus, this ban affects parking along the Midway Plaisance from Cottage Grove Avenue to Dorchester Avenue. For more information, visit cityofchicago.org.

NightRide

The NightRide shuttles are free to all University students, faculty, staff, and University of Chicago Medicine staff. To ride the shuttles, all passengers must present a valid UChicago or University of Chicago Medicine ID when boarding.

HOURS

NightRide operates seven nights a week (reduced service for holidays and summer). Sunday through Wednesday the shuttles run from 5 p.m. to 4 a.m. Thursday through Saturday the shuttles run from 5 p.m. to 6 a.m. The shuttles run approximately every 20-30 minutes, on the hour and half-hour.

STOPS

For your safety and the safety of all passengers, flag stops can only occur at intersections. To flag a shuttle in between designated stops, customers should safely stand at the intersection to allow the shuttle to safely pull over. Remember, NightRide operates when it is dark outside, so it is important to be visible to the driver and indicate to him or her that you would like to board.

To indicate a stop while on the shuttle, pull the cord or tell the driver. The driver will then stop at the next intersection.

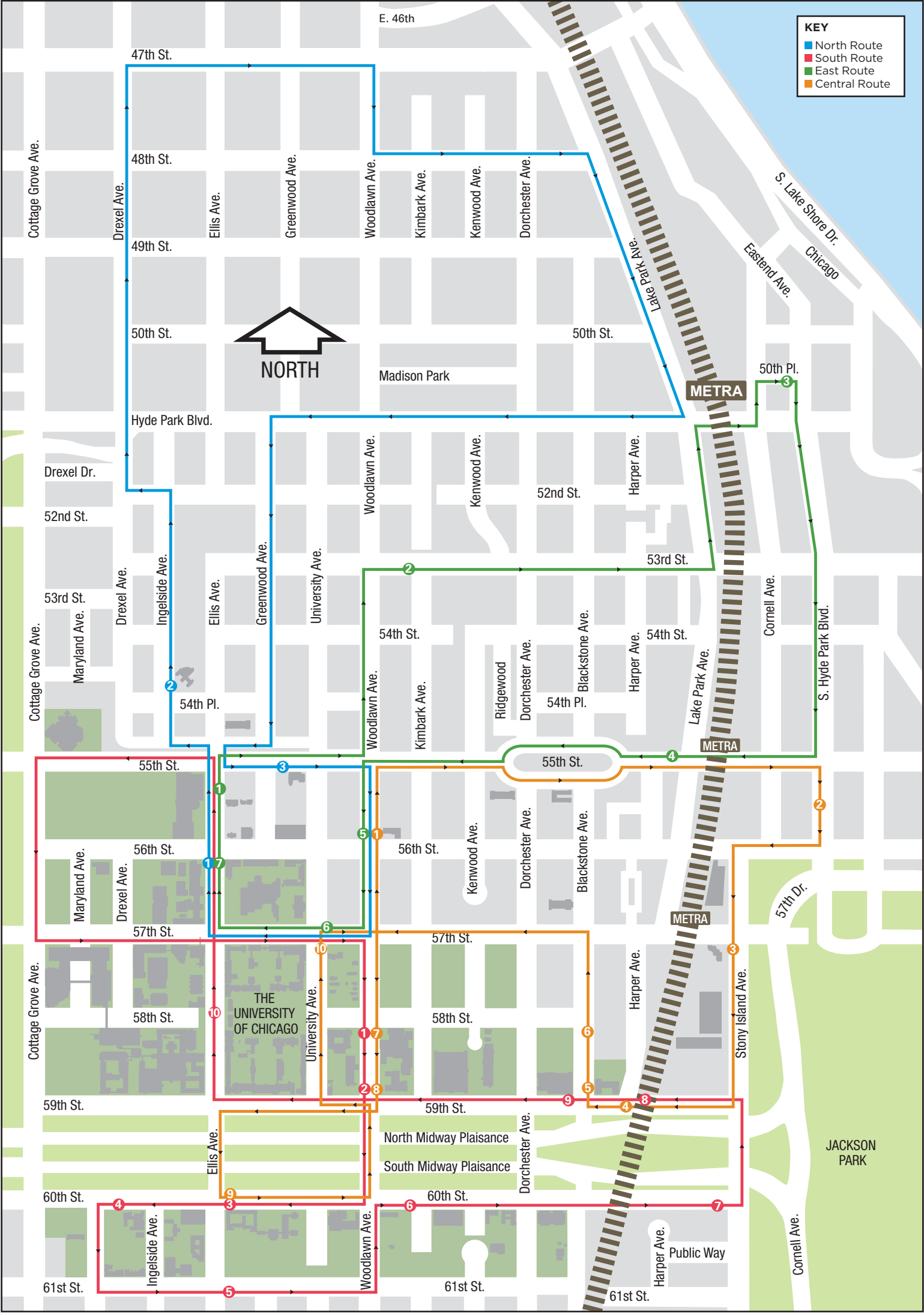
